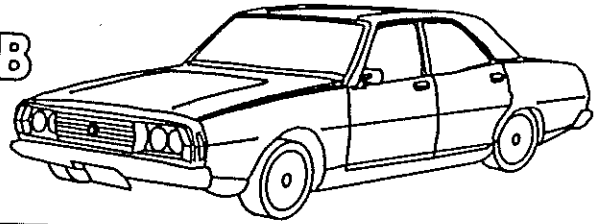

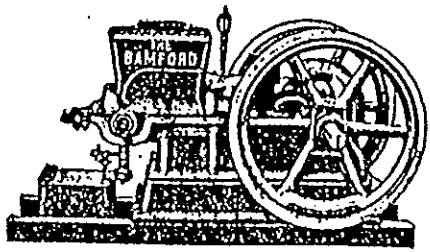

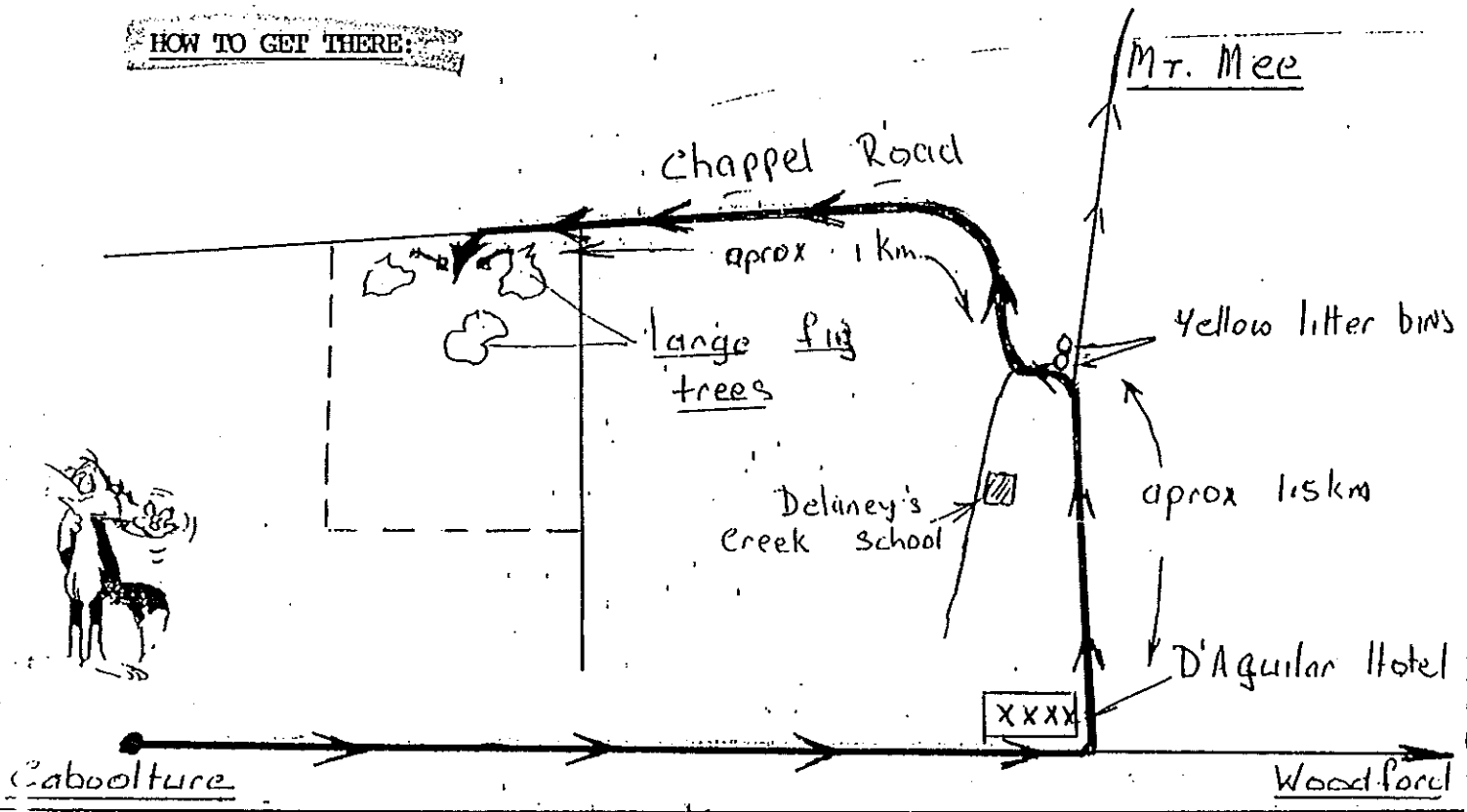

INTER CLUB DISTRIBUTION

Having recently received several requests from members for rear louvres, the S.A. Club is now taking orders for them. The only problem being that a minimum order of 50 is required by Auger. As this is a fairly large order to fulfill it would be appreciated that this notice is circulated to all members throughout the various club magazines/newsletters. We would also like to make members aware that this may be the last time louvres could become available due to the order requirements by Auger. From our correspondence with Auger, the minimum order shall be 50 units, and these will come in pack sizes of no less than 5 louvres and Auger will deliver to each capitol city. (Further advise on delivery shall follow at a later date.) The entire production quantity will need to be pre paid before production goes ahead, of which shall take approximately 6 weeks. The club price per louvre shall be \$95 inclusive and we would advise that each club order for their members the number required in pack sizes as previously mentioned. Further to this letter the S.A. Club would like a firm commitment from members by filling out the following order form and forward with money to their club Treasurer by October 31st 1992. Once all this information has been collated we would appreciate your club cheque and total number of packs required by the 6th November 1992.

N.B. The S.A. Club has set these dates to accommodate a reasonable club magazine distribution and response from members and that if production does go ahead deliveries will be approximately January 1993.

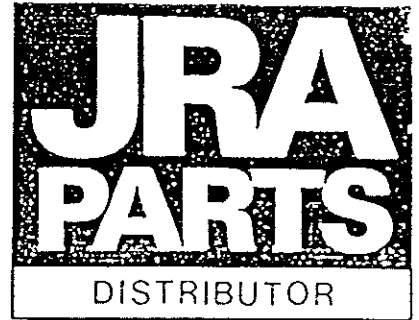

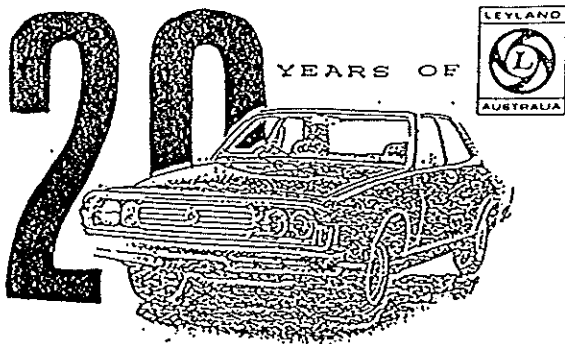

It includes a dining room, lecture room, games room, sporting fields and a swimming pool. Linen is not provided but can be hired at extra cost. The Centre advises that due to its charter, the consumption of alcohol on the grounds or in the buildings is not permitted.

In order to make the weekend a financial possibility for as many people as possible, we have kept the costs to an absolute minimum and are covering as much as we can from fund-raising and donations prior to the event. This means that once you have paid your registration fees, all activities other than the optional Saturday night and Sunday tours are FREE!!! A copy of "Anything But Average" is also included in the registration fee - further copies will be available for sale.

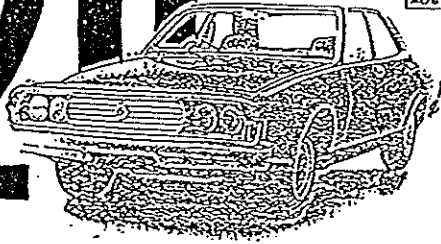
