IN ABOUT 90% OF THE CASES THE RUBBER PART OF THE MOUNT IS STILL IN GOOD CONDITION AND IT IS JUST THE INSERT THAT IS WORN OUT.

TO OVERCOME THIS PROBLEM AND SAVE CLUB MEMBERS SOME DOLLARS THE CLUB HAS SOME OF THE INSERTS MADE AND THEY LOOK JUST AS GOOD AS THE ONES MADE BY THE PROFESSIONAL SUSPENSION SHOPS.

THE CLUB IS SELLING THESE INSERTS IN THREE DIFFERENT WAYS.

THIS IS BECAUSE THE INSERTS NEED TO BE FITTED WITH A PRESS AS THEY ARE A VERY TIGHT FIT.
