N.B The Automatic Transmission is a Borg Warner 35 similar unit were fitted to both Valiant and Fords, hence the servicing of this transmission should not present any problems to a reputable transmission specialist.

The 4 speed and 3 speed manual gearboxes were also made by Borg Warner and though they are similar to those fitted to Valiants the ratios are different. Cluster gears are now difficult to obtain.


