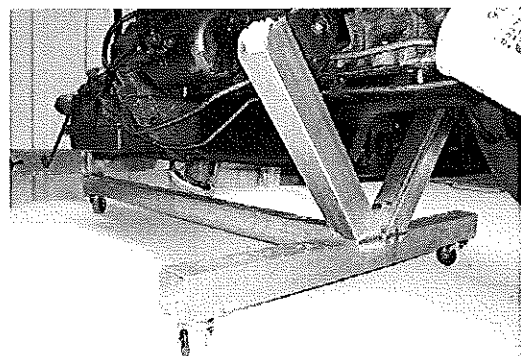
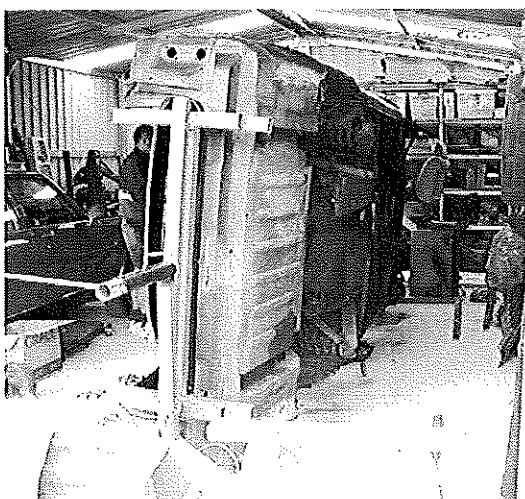
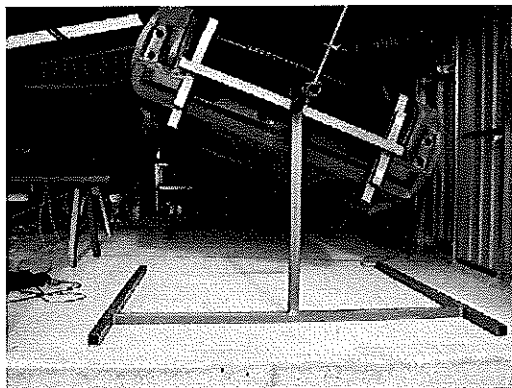
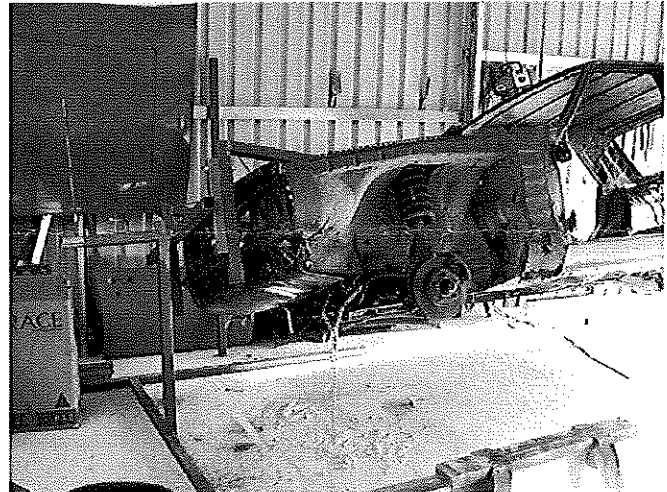
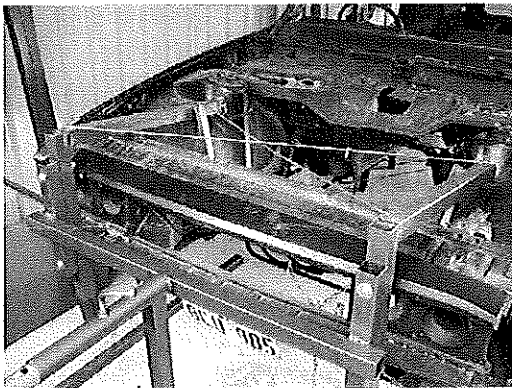


# Darryl Packham's Restoration

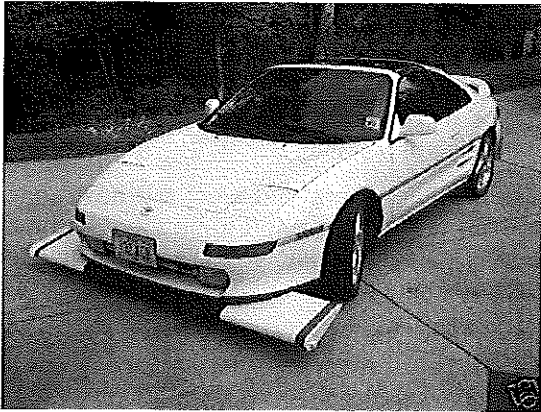

**Brief History:** Darryl's website is currently down but he has given me permission to publish these pics from it.

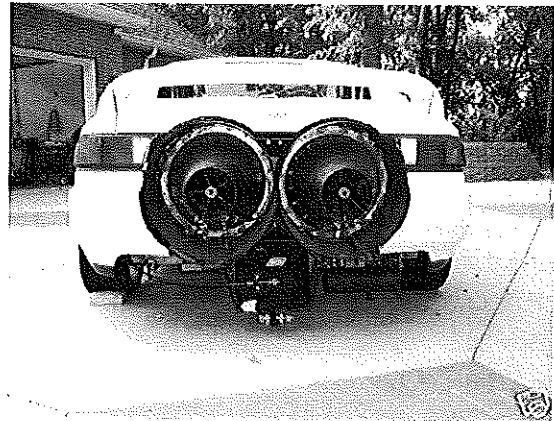

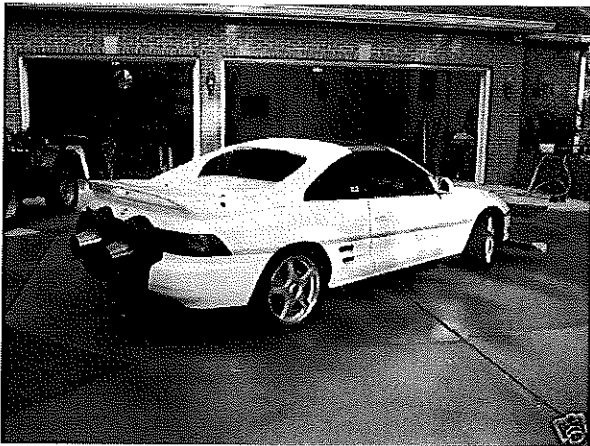
Looking for a little GRUNT ???  
..try *this* in your "P" ...



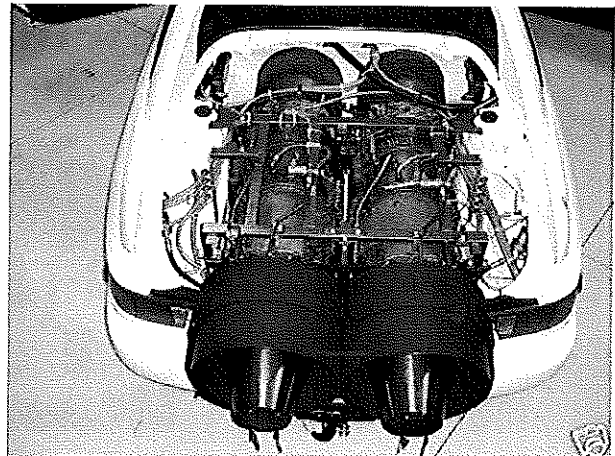
Take a perfectly ordinary looking Toyota MR2..



BUT.. stick a couple of *these* babies up the rear



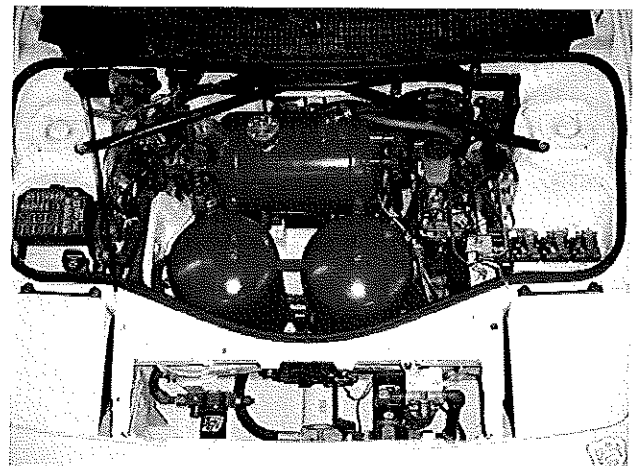
Some people would mistake them for a rather pretentious dual exhaust system

## ANNUAL GENERAL MEETING

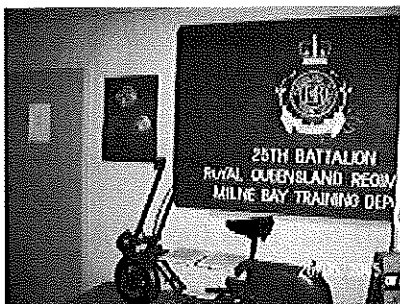
The next club meeting on Friday 12th August 2005 is the Annual General Meeting.

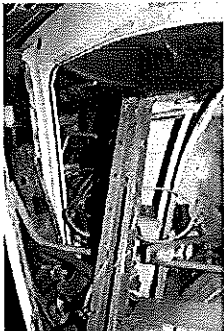
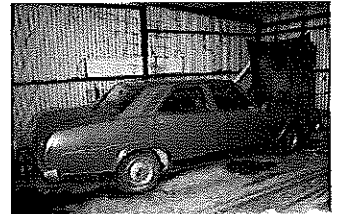
